Dear Parent and Carer,

After School Clubs – After school clubs start this week. All clubs should now be available to book on Parent Pay. For parents of pupils in Years 4 to 6, please ensure you select the correct option for collection or walking home at the end of club. A reminder that clubs in Reception, Year 1 and 2 are split into classes, with one class having the club this half term and the other class next half term. Clubs starting after half term will be available to book on the week commencing 21/10/24

Year 6 Gilwern Parent Meeting – We will be holding a meeting for parents to discuss the upcoming residential trip to Gilwern on **Tuesday 24th September at 4.30pm**. We will go through the activities and itinerary and give parents a chance to ask any questions they may have.

Harvest – We will be celebrating harvest this **Friday (20th September)**. We will, again, be supporting local food banks and would ask that parents donate tinned and packed foods so that we can donate locally. These can be brought in to school by Friday.

Breakfast Club – A reminder that children MUST be pre booked to be able to attend. Please do this via ParentPay for either paid Early Bird session (8.00am – 9.00am) or free Late Bird (8.20am – 9.00am). A reminder also that children should not arrive to school site early as they are not supervised until either 8.00am for Early bird or 8.20am for Late bird. Parents who are dropping their children for Breakfast club should use the side gate off the lane that goes down to the Fox or the main gates via the turning circle. Staff cars and delivery lorries come into the back car park between 8.00am and 8.40am.

Drop off and Pick Up - A reminder that there is no on site parking for parents available. Parents should park well away from the school gates and walk children to school. A reminder that all children up to year 3 must be dropped off and picked up by an adult.

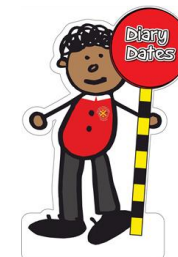

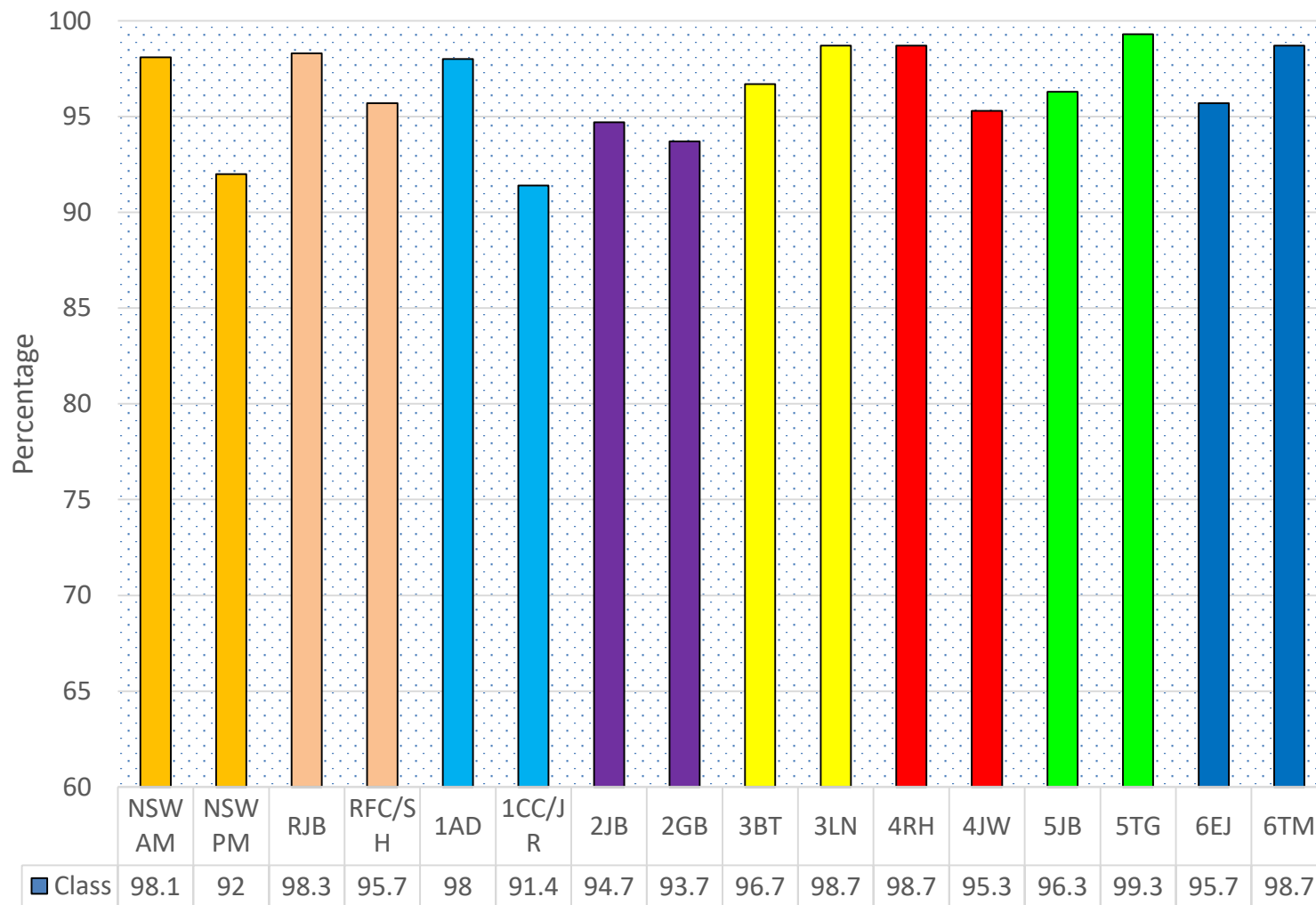

- 100%** (Smiley face icon)
 - not missing any lessons during term time. Present for all lessons activities and social time
 - 95%** (Neutral face icon)
 - missing in excess of two weeks of education. Absent from the classroom for up to three weeks and the loss of a significant amount of education
 - Under 92%** (Sad face icon)
 - missing more than 3 weeks of education. A serious loss of learning which is likely to have a detrimental effect on your child's achievement and life chances
