Here is some information for the week ending Friday 5<sup>th</sup> July

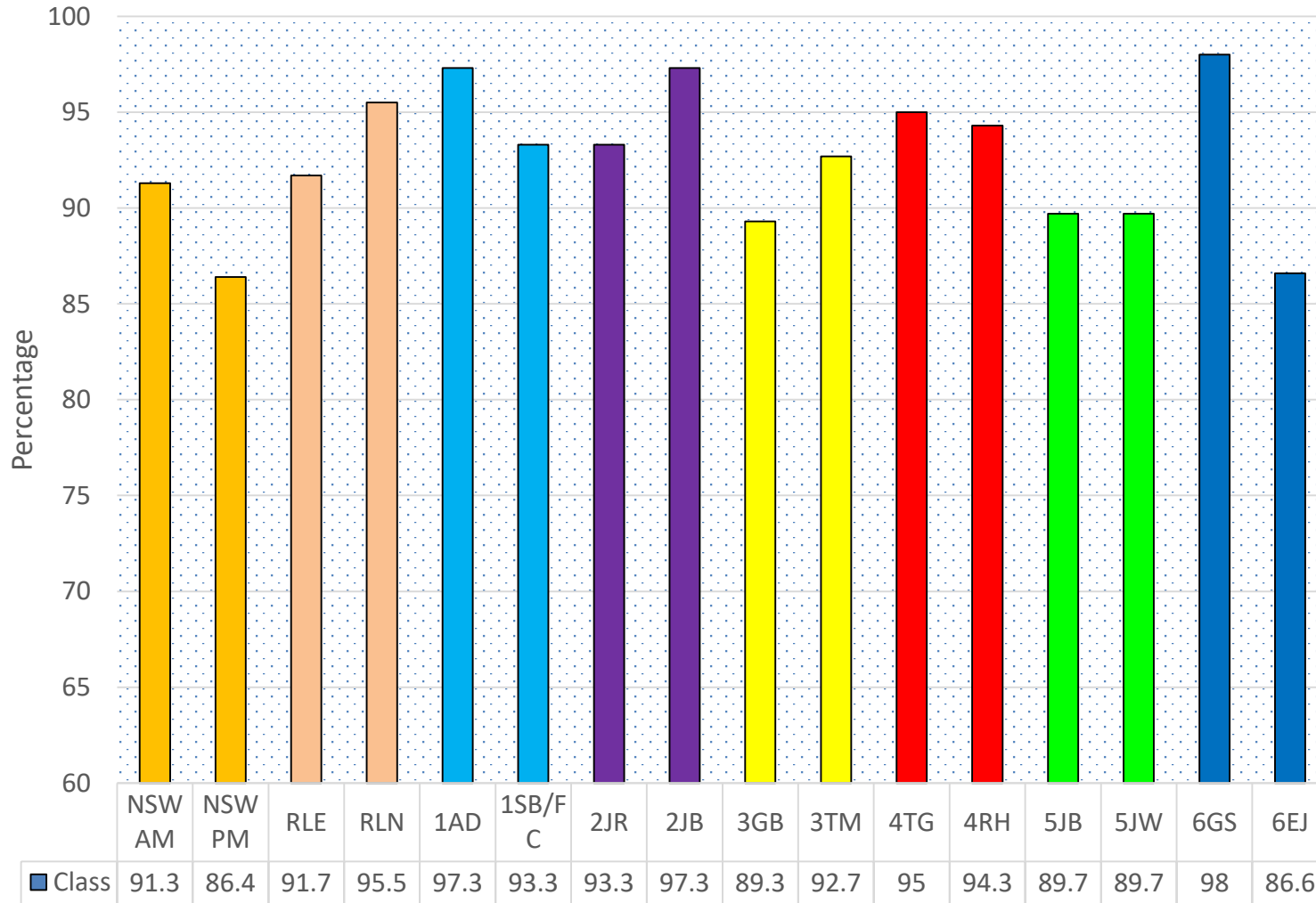
